



Level of Aspiration of Sindhi, Marawadi and Maratha Community females

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Community plays important role in the development of personlity. Community means a social group of any size whose members reside in a specific locality, share government, and often have a common culture and historical heritage. Culture means the behaviour and belief characteristics of a particular social, ethnic group. Values, tradition, belief system are related to the culture. All these factors are affecting on the behaviour of people of that community. Even the 'Self' which is the central ingredient of person`s personality is develop by social interaction. And aspiration is one of the chracteristics of personality.

Aspiration means a longing for and striving after something higher than oneself of one`s present status. Aspirations are the goals a person sets for himself in tasks which have intense personal significance or in which his ego involved.

To study about the level of aspiration is useful for empowerment of women .By keeping this thought in mind a researcher conducted a survey to understand the level of aspiration of females of three communities. For that researcher selected randomly females from sindhi, marawadi and maratha community as a sample for this study.

The information of this study would be useful for social institution to plan their schemes for these particular communties. Counsellors may use this information to understand the aspiration and achievement of this particular female group. Thus this information became useful for improvement in females of these communities.

This will be helpful to motivate the researchers of psychology and educators and encourage them to research in these field.

Objectives :-

- 1) To understand the direction of goal setting of sindhi, marawadi and maratha community females.
- 2) To understand the extent of level of aspiration among sindhi, marawadi and maratha community fe-

males.

Hypothesis:-

1) There is no difference in the direction of goal setting of sindhi, marawadi and maratha community females.

2) There is difference in extent of level of aspiration among sindhi, marawadi and maratha community females.

METHOD

Sample:- Total 90 female have been taken as sample for this study, out of which 30 females have been taken from sindhi community, 30 females have been taken from marawadi community and remaining 30 females have been taken from maratha community. This sample has been selected randomly.

Tools Used for Study:-1)Level of Aspiration Measurement by Dr.Mahesh Bhargava and Prof..M.A.Shah.This is a standardized Psychological measurement test.

Data Collection:- For present study researcher were collected data from 90 females in which each 30 females were from each community.

The levels of aspiration measurement test was used to collect the data from each females. This test was given to each female and request to do the require particular work.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

To study the first hypothesis the data was analyzed and compared the mean values of sindhi, marawadi and maratha community`s females. The obtain mean values are respectively 1.710, .980 and 1.575. The average of these means is 1.482.Which indicate that they have positive direction in their goal setting. To study the second hypothesis for that the data was analyzed by using analysis of variance.

Reseacher compared all these three groups e.g. sindhi, marawadi and maratha communities in extent of their level of aspiration. The obtain 'F' values is 1.220. When this 'F' value compared with 'P' value

(probability value). It has been found that whatever the difference in their level of aspiration is due to chance factors. Hence the second hypotheses of this study is rejected.

FINDINGS 1) There is no statistically significant difference in direction of goal setting among sindhi, marawadi and maratha community females. 2) There is no statistically significant difference in extent of level of aspiration among sindhi, marawadi and maratha community females.

CONCLUSION

It has been seen that there is common tendency

in people is that they always set the goal at high, and the same has been found about these three communities. But it is important to study the direction of goal setting. In order to study this phenomenon researcher did efforts to study about this community. And it is found that all these three means sindhi, marawadi and maratha community females have same direction of goal setting. That is they have positive direction in goal setting. When researcher considered the extent of the level of aspiration it has been found that they all have same extent of level of aspiration. Meaning that they have same self imposed standard against which they judges their own performance.

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
